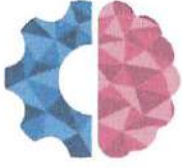

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Global Business School and Research Centre (GBSRC) in association with DPU Foundation for Innovation, Incubation and Entrepreneurship (DPU FIIE) under Institute Innovation Council organized a whole day Workshop on “**Navigating the Venture Capital Landscape for Startups**” on Saturday, 10th February 2024. The speaker for the day was Dr. Sandeep Sahasrabudhe. The objective of the session was to increase the awareness among the students about the financial planning and wealth management. The session commenced with the introduction of the guest given by Ms. Aastha Talreja studying in MBA 1st year.

Dr. Sandeep Sahasrabudhe has extensive leadership experience of diverse industries which includes finance, real estate, and the hospitality industry. Currently serving as the Managing Director of Moneywise Wealth Planners in Pune and Mumbai, he is deeply dedicated in guiding individuals and businesses towards securing their financial futures through comprehensive planning and wealth management. Dr. Sandeep also holds a pivotal role as the Managing Director of Pinewoods Golf Club and is the Director of Worldwide Properties in Thailand, Greece, Georgia, and UAE, which has enabled him to make significant impact on the global real estate landscape. 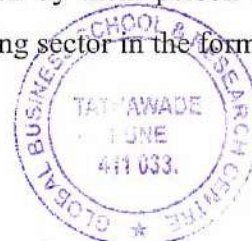

Learning Solutions and Financial Planning Academy in Mumbai, nurturing the talents of aspiring financial professionals. Sir has authored a book named 'Demystifying asset classes' which guides the investors in making wise, tactful and sensible investments in different asset classes. The guest was further felicitated by Dr. Avinash Ghadge with the token of appreciation and started to guide students about financial planning and wealth management.

Dr. Sandeep addressed about the growing population in India and their investment methodology, as the current trend is to become rich as soon as possible without waiting for too long but for this the people are engaging in wrong earning activities like gambling, unethical sites, gaming apps etc. The best way to spend and invest money is through mutual funds with the help and advice of CFP (certified financial planner). For doing investment intellectually we need to quantify the amount.

As the kinds of investment are short, medium and long term like Japan goes for investment plans in retirement which serves them for long term but in contrary Indians only invest 9% of their wealth for retirement which makes them dependable. In India major part of income is invested in gold, real-estate and fixed deposits. According to old methodology savings is equal to income minus expense but If we direct savings in the best way then it turns to be in fruitful investments and also the old methodology must be changed into income minus investment is equal to the money which we need to spend on our expenditure. Further it was added by Dr. Sandeep that there are two types of real estate one which is self-occupied and other one through which we earn is by giving property on rents but still we are earning negative rental yield that is -6%. Sir also told us about the stock market (ETF) exchange traded fund and its growth. He also shared his views on the variety available in mutual funds like funds for life insurance, term insurance and the mixture available of insurance and investment but it must be separated. Investment done in gold serves the two sides of the coin as it is easy to liquidate which makes it readily available and perhaps difficult to safe. Investment done in the sources from where one could expect higher return can also prove to be a source from where money can be lost soon like gambling, investing in cryptocurrency instead one should follow the strategy of warren buffet which says to buy investment assets and hold them for long term. The guest also made us aware about the Ultra High Net Worth Individuals, individuals having income around 1 million U.S \$ and High Net worth Individuals, individuals having income around 20 million U.S \$ as they are the income source for the wealth managers. Dr. Sandeep also spoke about the no. of companies present in mutual funds where 51% Indians and 49% are foreign and India is on the 4th position in selling of high value of shares. Sir demonstrated the qualities of stock market and compared it with qualities seen by them person in their partner. He also informed and made us aware about the mistake done by banking sector in the form of giving loans and also

shared his views on diversification and portfolio management. Stocks can be highest earning source he emphasized on the wrong practices undertook by people working in corporates for earning like doing insider trading. An individual can't be depended for earning through stock market only as it is an uncertain market like shares of kingfisher have no value now. Guest also spoke about the way of investing like what one should follow and it goes like this

- Early start
- Don't break SIPs
- Monitor your growth
- Set a benchmark for checking growth like Sensex, Nifty
- Buy in cash and sell in financial derivatives

Financial advisor is important this was quoted by giving example from the Hindu literature The Mahabharat "Saarathi Jaroori Hai"

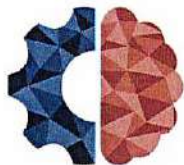


