Awareness session on Anti – ragging by Col. (Dr.) Derek D'Souza.

Col. (Dr.) Derek D'Souza, *Director, Students Training & Development, DPU* addressed all the BBA students attended the lecture on Anti ragging rules and regulations. The speaker started with making everyone aware about what actually counts in ragging and further spoke about the anti – ragging laws. He read out the notification given by UGC to all students and discussed the seriousness about the same.

All the students were made aware about how to file complaint in case if ragging is experienced by them. Further, he spoke about how quickly the committee takes action if a complaint is received.

Thereafter, the session was taken on Ethics, Soft Skills, and Personal Growth & Self –development for professionals. He showered his knowledge on multiple topics like values, reflection, and how all this terms are important for us in life.

Session was filled with enthusiasm when sir took an activity to identify the high points of the student's life and made them interact through letting them narrate it in front of the class. He also shared a story on true happiness. A Group activity was conducted, where groups had to select 6 items from the list of 12 items to survive on a desired island and justify the reason for the selected items. After everyone did their best to select items sir told about the use if every items and importance of the one item everybody ignored and added the value of never underestimating the potential of anyone.

Session by Dr. Babasaheb Jadhav on ASSESSMENT PATTERN & EXAMINATION SYSTEM

Dr. Babasaheb Jadhav, Associate Prof., GBSRC began with overview of the specialization offered by the institute and many other points like, importance of Exams, grades are temporary but education is permanent, and other important aspects of life. A detailed discussion was held on examination process and the role of examination department, how to fill examination form, and information about ERP was provided. Overview of credit and grading system was provided along with internal and external examination.

There are six courses available for FY-BBA which carries 50:50 evaluation system including internal as well as external exam, besides the Continuous Concurrent Internal evaluation. Detailed overview of CCE Continuous Concurrent Internal evaluation was conducted that includes mid-term, term-end, assignments, project and activity based learning, case study, class presentations and attendance. Minimum attendance to appear for examination is 75% and passing criteria is 40% in both internal as well as external examination. In case of backlog the student have to give the examination again in next semester. SIP and Internship is of 2 months and in mid-term, students will get options in the question paper. Talking about grading system and GPA, he said CGPA will be given out of 8. He said Exams are just a medium to evaluation and shared best wishes to all the students.

Session by Dr Deepali Garge on Awareness about Women Anti - Harassment committee

Dr Deepali Garge, Associate Prof, GBSRC, presented with an overview about the mission of

GBSRC. Discussing about the respect for women, a video was shown about women harassment

across countries. Hence, the issue is of global importance. Ma'am talked about the committee which

is responsible for Women Anti - harassment and introduced the students to the Members of the

committee. Later on she talked about do's and don'ts of the committee.

Lessons and morals of life BY Mrs. Monika Joshi

Mrs. Monika Joshi, Manager, CSR-Volunteering for Asia Pacific, TATA Technologies Ltd.

interacted with all the students from BBA and MBA together in the smart classroom. She told different stories to students based on which she focused on important lessons and morals of life required for leading a better life and which would help them in sustaining in corporate world. She told 3 stories to students. And then she asked them few questions and interacted with them and shared her

experience of corporate life and further answered few questions asked by the students. Later on she discussed about her college life experience and how she changed her perspective towards studies

and life.

Getting started with ERP BY: Dr. Priyanka Bobade

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Dr. Priyanka Bobade, Associate Professor, GBSRC conducted the session on college ERP to make the students aware about the ERP of the college with complete details with the practical demonstration. The session included the topics of varied ERP toolbar like attendance and e-notes and others like library, timetable, assignments etc. The session was quite interesting and students were responsive towards the adaptation of ERP.

Life at Campus BY: Dr. Snehal Maheshkar

Dr.Snehal Maheshkar, Professor, GBSRC interacted with students and started with a small activity which taught the students that whatever we do there should be a purpose to do that. Further, the session got more interesting as ma'am related the topic to the real life and hence students also participated enthusiastically. Then the session headed towards VUCA world which stands for Volatility, Uncertainty, Complexity, Ambiguity and how to overcome this. It was discussed that how co-curricular activities help us to build our personality and how we learned varied things from that like team building and gaining confidence. At last madam also showed an AV prepared by her which included the images of all the events which takes place here at GBSRC.

Management Games

After the lunch break students were taken to play few management games. First game was about passing on the action to our next person which taught the students about nonverbal communication. The second game was played balloon passing where players were divided into teams of 3 and had to pass on the balloon from start to end point. 8 teams played the game wherein team 4 won the game by successfully passing 5 balloons within 2 minutes.
