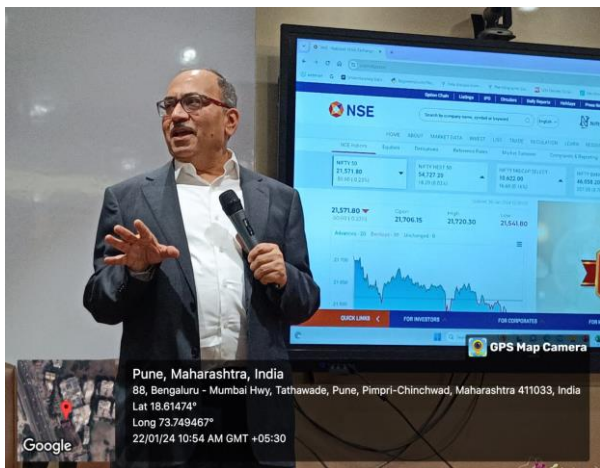

The "Navigating Entrepreneurship Opportunities in Financial Services" workshop, held on January 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2024, was a hallmark event under the aegis of the Institution's Innovation Council and IQAC GBSRC, in collaboration with Aditya Birla Capital's Corporate Social Responsibility initiative and the National Institute of Securities Markets (NISM). This initiative was specifically designed to foster financial entrepreneurship among the youth, with a particular focus on MBA first-year students. The workshop featured distinguished speakers, including Mr. Shiv Kumar Bhasin, a seasoned professional with extensive experience in the financial sector, and Mr. Rohit Warman, who boasts 17 years of financial services experience across equity advisory, financial modeling, and significant contributions to corporate financial automation and academia.

This two-day workshop provided a foundation for financial literacy and investment strategies, specifically geared towards aspiring entrepreneurs. The first session stressed the importance of setting financial goals and budgeting to achieve them. It also explained the difference between saving and investing, highlighting that inflation erodes the value of saved money over time. The second session covered various investment opportunities including stocks, bonds, real estate, commodities, and cash equivalents. It emphasized the importance of diversification and strategic asset allocation based on individual risk tolerance and goals.

They learn how to diversify income streams, understand market dynamics, and manage risk.
